- Plastic bottles: red box/bin with red sticker
- Metal packaging: black box/bin with blacksticker

Paper & card Your blue box or labelled bin

- ✓ Cardboard packaging and boxes - cut up large pieces of card
- ✓ Shredded paper recommended for confidential papers
- ✓ Greeting cards

- X Milk or drink cartons
- Polystyrene or plastics

Your glass bin You are required to provide your own bin for glass

- ✓ Yes please
- ✓ Glass bottles
- ✓ Glass jars
- ✓ Broken glass

- > Remove plastic labels (paper labels can be left

on)
